Personal buoyancy, must be in good repair and comply with **R1**.

Mainsail Fastening. The mainsail shall be capable of being lowered easily by hand at the base of the mast in both the capsized and upright position **R4**.

Foils, must be securely attached to the boat in such a way that once capsized cannot detach from the boat **R5,R8**.

Masts.

Hollow masts shall be either:

(a) Completely sealed to prevent the entry of water, or

(b) Have a adequately sized drain hole within 300mm of the base of the mast **and/or**

(c) Have 30% of the mast, measured from the top, filled with closed cell rigid foam.**R6**

Bailers Boats that are not self draining shall carry one adequate bailer in addition to transom flaps or venturi type bailers.**R7**

Recommendations

It is strongly recommended by Beaumaris Yacht Club that all Crews

Carry an appropriate shackle key and knife whilst afloat.

Wear footwear that will protect the crews feet whilst afloat.

All boats carry at least one useable paddle.

Have fitted a towing ring of no less than 40mm internal diameter and a metal thickness of no less than 4mm be permanently attached to the bow.

Children under 12 years old wear a PFD 1 in accordance with Victorian law.

Attention is drawn to AYF Racing Rules of Sailing 01-04' Addendum A Part 2 Off the beach boats recommendations 1 racing which states

It is the sole responsibility of each boat to decide whether or not to start or to continue to race.
